Program Notes

Virginia's Heritage Music Trail: The Crooked Road has been an organization focusing on the heritage music and musicians of Southwest Virginia since 2004. During this time, the Crooked Road has initiated programs to present heritage music through performances inside the Southwest Virginia region, as well as throughout the Mid-Atlantic region. These performances are part of the Crooked Road on Tour program, which celebrates traditional music at community gatherings and public performances and encourages interested people to visit the region.

The Crooked Road's Music and Dance Spectacular: Celebrating Southwest Virginia's Heritage Music features the variety of traditional musical styles found in the region, from bluegrass and old-time to ballads and blues influences. Generations of musicians continue to share in these musical experiences, and new voices and styles are born from generational legacies while new groups are formed with deep connections to the history and traditions from the Blue Ridge Mountains of Virginia.

This showcase of heritage music features a robust line-up of traditional talents. A force of bluegrass, the **Junior Sisk Band** hails from the Virginia Blue Ridge. The members are masters of instrumentation and songwriting, and the band is well-known and well-recognized from organizations such as International Bluegrass Music Association (IBMA) and Society for the Preservation of Bluegrass Music of America (SPGBMA) for its talents. Bringing a legacy of old-time sounds to the stage is the **Whitetop Mountain Band**, an award-winning family ensemble that has longtime traditional roots in the Whitetop area of Southwest Virginia. The band has been an essential force in preservation of traditional music, tunes, and education. **Dori Freeman**, an Appalachian singer and songwriter, highlights her roots with traditional ballads and new favorites with her father, **Scott Freeman**, and grandfather, **Willard Gayheart**. Their family's history highlights the importance of generational legacy, as well as the Galax music scene. **Justin Golden** unites the Virginia blues with heritage music of Southwest Virginia. Singing everything from country blues to Americana, soul, indie roots, and beyond, Golden brings his songwriting and guitar talents to heart-and-soul issues. Traditional dance is highlighted by percussive dancer **Becky Hill**, who is dedicated to creating innovative choreography rooted in Appalachian music and dance. **Eugene Wolf**, of the Brother Boys and long-time Barter Theatre resident actor, helps weave the collective narrative of song and experiences on the stage.

Music has been a prominent cultural force in the mountainous region of Southwest Virginia for centuries. Generally an outlet for gatherings outside of work, music has been integral from church services to larger gatherings such as fairs, fiddlers conventions, and dances. The diversion that music provided

to growing communities was welcome as both a cause of happiness but also as a connection to the roots and family legacies from which the settlers immigrated. Various European and African influences can still be heard in today's heritage music.

As the Crooked Road moves toward its 20th anniversary in 2024, the importance of programming such as this performance will encourage new audiences to engage with Southwest Virginia's heritage music. The joy and celebration of the culture is something that the Crooked Road looks forward to expanding and touring throughout the United States.

About the Crooked Road



The Crooked Road was founded in 2004 and is designated as Virginia's Heritage Music Trail by the State of Virginia. The 330-mile music trail is based in Southwest Virginia on Route 58 and includes 19 counties, four cities, over 50 towns, five regional planning districts, various tourism organizations, nine major venues, and over 60 affiliated venues and festivals.

The Crooked Road focuses on traditional heritage music, such as bluegrass and old-time music. The organization's mission includes youth music education, promotion of heritage music and artists from the region and preservation of the history of the region's unique heritage music.

The Crooked Road works with local governments, community leaders, venues, and tourism organizations to market the music of the region to encourage visitation and increase economic impact while celebrating and developing appreciation of heritage music through music experiences.

Biographies



WHITETOP MOUNTAIN BAND

The Whitetop Mountain Band is a family-based band from Whitetop, Virginia, an area rich in the old-time music tradition. The members have done much to preserve the Whitetop region's style of old-time fiddling and banjo picking and are legendary musicians and teachers of the style while entertaining audiences with fiddle/banjo instrumentals and powerful solos and harmony vocals on blues, classic country, honky-tonk, traditional bluegrass numbers, old-timey ballads, originals, and four-part mountain gospel songs. The group has played numerous festivals, including the Smithsonian Folklife Festival, National Folk Life Festival, World Music Institute in New York City, and the Carter Family Festival. In October 2012 the Virginia Senate gave the group a proclamation for contributions to the music of Southwest Virginia.

The band includes Spencer family members Emily Spencer on clawhammer banjo and vocals; Martha Spencer on guitar, fiddle, vocals, and dance; and Kilby Spencer on fiddle. Additionally, Debbie Bramer of Fancy Gap is featured on bass, vocals, and dance, and rounding out the group is Ersel Fletcher on vocals, guitar, and dance, hailing from the Glade Spring area.



BECKY HILL

Becky Hill is a percussive dancer, choreographer, and square dance caller. Hill was a 2021 Strathmore artist-in-residence, a 2018 OneBeat Fellow for the U.S. State Department, and is currently an artist-in-residence at the John C. Campbell Folk School. She performs with the T-Mart

Rounders and teaches dance throughout the country. As an avid organizer and teacher, Hill's work is deeply rooted in the intersections between music, dance, and community. She believes there is always more to learn and is dedicated to creating innovative choreography rooted in Appalachian music and dance. For more information about Hill, visit rebeccahill.org.

JUSTIN GOLDEN

On his debut record, *Hard Times and a Woman*, guitarist and songwriter Justin Golden showcases the full breadth of the genre and its downstream influences, everything from country blues to Americana, soul, indie roots, and beyond. Golden was raised on the Virginia coast and is steeped in the distinctive, fingerpicked Piedmont blues of the central part of the state. He's studied country blues and can name any number of influences, from Blind Boy Fuller to Taj Mahal, but his key inspirations have always come from the indie guitar realm. Golden, a trained archeologist, understands history—specifically the history of this genre—thanks to mentors such as Phil Wiggins, and now teaches the next generation of youth blues guitarists.



DORI FREEMAN

Dori Freeman is about as “bona fide” as an Appalachian artist can be: she was raised among a family of musicians in the mountains of Southwest Virginia. Freeman’s fourth studio album, *Ten Thousand Roses*, showcases an artist who has cemented an inimitable signature sound while simultaneously establishing her as capable of a wide variety of styles. Freeman is a multi-faceted eclectic artist, defying and expanding notions of what it means to be someone from the region, a young woman in the music industry, and an Americana artist.

SCOTT FREEMAN AND WILLARD GAYHEART

Willard Gayheart and Scott Freeman are consummate musicians, storytellers, teachers, songwriters, and tunesmiths, and to say they are versatile would be an impressive understatement. Though grounded in old-time tradition, their music is adventurous and ready to roam the edges for new sounds and songs that fit within the tradition. Freeman plays mandolin, guitar, and fiddle and has a smooth baritone vocal style that he uses to great effect on his own songs as well as those of others. Gayheart, a renowned pencil artist, is a hugely gifted songwriter that captures Appalachian life in song like a firefly in a jar for all to marvel at.



JUNIOR SISK BAND

Junior Sisk, a long time resident of the Virginia Blue Ridge, is widely recognized as one of today's top bluegrass guitar players and vocalists. Influenced by a father who wrote songs and played guitar and a mother who sang, Sisk first learned to play around age 14. He has won numerous awards, including the International Bluegrass Music Association (IBMA)'s "Album of the Year" and "Song of the Year" awards in 2012 and "Male Vocalist of the Year" award in 2013 and 2017, while his band earned the 2014 Society for the Preservation of Bluegrass Music of America (SPBGMA) "Bluegrass Band of the Year" award.

The Junior Sisk Band comprises a variety of bluegrass powerhouse players, including Heather Berry Mabe (guitar and vocals), IBMA and SPBGMA award winner and nominee; Tony Mabe (banjo, guitar, and vocals), multi-instrumentalist and Galax Old Fiddlers Convention award winner; Johnathon Dillon (mandolin and vocals), longtime member of Junior Sisk and Rambler's Choice and the Junior Sisk Band; Curt Love (bass), longtime bluegrass lover and banjo and bass player; and Doug Bartlett (fiddle and vocals), former member of Doyle Lawson and Quicksilver (recording no less than three albums), the Lonesome River Band, the James King Band, Del McCoury Band, and others.



EUGENE WOLF

Eugene Wolf is a native of Greeneville, Tennessee, and studied music and theatre at the University of Tennessee at Knoxville. Wolf was a member of the Road Company and has been a member of Barter Theatre's Resident Acting Company for 24 years. In 2002 Wolf found home in the role of A.P. Carter in Barter Theatre's *Keep on the Sunny Side*, as well as on BBC's *Lost Highway* and *Will the Circle Be Unbroken* for PBS American Experience. He has been a member of the Brother Boys with Ed Snodderly for 35 years. His one-man show, *The Book of Mamaw*, played the United Solo Festival in New York City in 2019 and took home the United Solo/Backstage Audience Award. Wolf is the host of *What in the World*, a weekly radio show for WEHC-FM, featuring world music, and is the winner of the 2019 Arts Alliance of the Mountain Empire Arts (AAME) Achievement Award.

The Moss Arts Center previously hosted Crooked Road events in 2014, 2015, and 2019. Dori Freeman first performed at the Moss Arts Center in 2017. This is the first performance at the Moss Arts Center for the other performers.

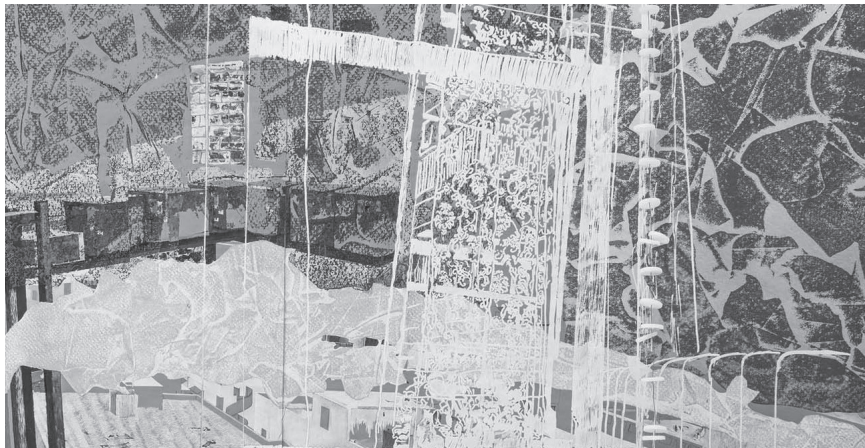

Land Acknowledgement

Virginia Tech acknowledges that we live and work on the Tutelo/Monacan People's homeland and we recognize their continued relationships with their lands and waterways.
