Program Notes

New Work: EDGAR MEYER Concertino for 14 Strings and Bass

Fourteen years ago, Scottish Ensemble and I did a short tour together where we played, among other things, the first movement of a string quintet that I had written previously. We performed it using the entire ensemble. The combination of the larger forces and the beautiful playing of the group created a multidimensional look that I had not seen before with this piece. We agreed to do it again.

That brings us to the Concertino for 14 Strings and Bass, completed March 20, 2022. One week ago today, to say it another way. So we are all getting to know what this piece is, but I will tell you some of what I know.

It is in three movements, but played without pause. The first starts with a gentle pulse from the orchestra. The bass then starts with a scalar melody that is ambiguous regarding its meter, but this melody eventually shows that it is primarily in seven, while never totally giving up its ambiguity. The middle of the movement adds a device that is new to me as of three months ago. For the duration of the orchestral *tutti* (the loud one with a soft ending), the upper strings all move exclusively in diminished scales, while the bass line moves exclusively in whole tone scales; but the resulting chords are sequences of either entirely major or entirely minor chords.

The second moment is primarily calm (with some agitation) and built around a simple 12-bar melody that is played three times consecutively. The melody is partially covered with bass goings on during the first two times, then the bass leaves and the ensemble presents the melody completely uncovered.

The third movement is rondo of sorts, with a few too many notes for everybody.

CAROLINE SHAW Punctum

The idea of "punctum" comes from renowned essayist and theorist Roland Barthes. Summed up very crudely (it's a complex and much-debated topic, which those interested in photography may wish to explore), it refers to the unexpected, entirely subjective effects of a piece of art—in Barthes' case, a photograph—on the observer: "[the] element which rises from the scene, shoots out of it like an arrow, and pierces me."

This intriguing idea is the inspiration for Caroline Shaw's tapestry of moments;

an exploration of expectation and disruption, communal and personal, familiarity and surprise. "A particular secondary dominant" from Bach's St. Matthew Passion is our center of gravity, but, along with other comforting musical intervals and harmonic progressions, it is strung out, splintered, fragmented, dissolving and reemerging like memories. In denying us of their usual familiarity and patterns, what "shoots out" to pierce us forms a wholly personal sonic photograph of our own.

RALPH VAUGHAN WILLIAMS, arr. Johnson The Lark Ascending

Ralph Vaughan Williams is inarguably one of finest and most important British composers of the 20th century. As with [Edward] Elgar, his music has become almost synonymous with the sound of "Englishness," borne out of both the influences of English folk song and Tudor polyphony, which can be heard throughout so much of his music, as well as his subject matter—a Renaissance court composer; Greensleeves; London. He is also admired for the wide-ranging span of his compositions, which include choral works, opera, symphonies, and concerti.

This hauntingly beautiful piece is one of Vaughan Williams' most enduringly popular works, continually topping classical "best-known" or "most-loved" polls, frequently heard in ads, films, and documentaries.

It first appeared as a piece for solo violin and piano in 1914, on the brink of World War I, inspired by a poem by the English poet George Meredith, which depicted the upwards soaring and circling of a songbird. It was revised six years later as a serene romance for orchestra and solo violin, receiving its premiere in 1921, played by the violinist for whom Vaughan Williams had first written it, Marie Hall.

Given that its two publication dates flanked one of the most horrific periods of warfare, death, and loss that Britain had known, its subject—the peaceful flights and fillips of a small innocent bird—seems to have taken on an even weightier sense of quiet beauty in the almost 100 years since its premiere performance, encapsulating for some the calming, healing passivity of the English countryside, and nature in general. The solo violin's near perfect evocation of the lark's "chirrup, whistle, slur, and shake," as it soars above delicate orchestral support, certainly demonstrates the composer's mastery of the pastoral concept.

Biographies

EDGAR MEYER, double bass and composer

Hailed by the *New Yorker* as "...the most remarkable virtuoso in the relatively unchronicled history of his instrument," Edgar Meyer's uniqueness in the field was recognized when he became the only bassist to be awarded the Avery Fisher Prize and also by a MacArthur Award. Meyer's most recent recording is *Not Our First Goat Rodeo* with Stuart Duncan, Aoife O'Donovan, Yo-Yo Ma, and Chris Thile. He was honored with his fifth Grammy Award in 2015 for his *Bass & Mandolin* recording with Thile. As a composer, his music has been premiered and recorded by Emanuel Ax, Joshua Bell, Ma, the Boston Symphony Orchestra, Béla Fleck, Zakir Hussain, Hilary Hahn, and the Emerson String Quartet, among others. The Nashville Symphony and the Aspen Music Festival and School commissioned his first purely orchestral work, which was premiered by the Nashville Symphony in March 2017. Additionally, Bravo! Vail and the Academy of St. Martin in the Fields commissioned an Overture for Violin and Orchestra that was premiered by Bell and the Academy of St. Martin in the Fields in June 2017.

SCOTTISH ENSEMBLE

Scottish Ensemble is the U.K.'s leading string orchestra, a core of outstanding string players who perform together under Artistic Director Jonathan Morton. Based in Glasgow, Scotland, Scottish Ensemble inspires audiences in the U.K. and beyond with vibrant performances that are powerful, challenging, and rewarding experiences, crossing genres, styles, musical periods, and artistic forms to offer fresh perspectives on classical music.

Scottish Ensemble regularly collaborates with high-profile guest artists, from trumpeter Alison Balsom and mezzo-soprano Sarah Connolly to cellist Pieter Wispelwey and violinists Patricia Kopatchinskaja and Nicola Benedetti. JONATHAN MORTON, Scottish Ensemble artistic director

Jonathan Morton is a musician equally at home in old and new music who enjoys collaborating with musicians and artists from different traditions.

Morton is artistic director at Scottish Ensemble, where his eclectic and engaging programming has been enthusiastically praised by audiences internationally, offering fresh perspectives on familiar repertoire and championing new works. Under his leadership, Scottish Ensemble has been collaborating increasingly with other art forms such as dance, visual arts, and theatre. Recent critically acclaimed projects include 20th Century Perspectives with artist Toby Paterson, Goldberg Variations—ternary patterns for insomnia with Andersson Dance, and Anno with Anna Meredith and Eleanor Meredith.

Morton is also principal first violin at London Sinfonietta, where he has been given the opportunity to work closely with many of today's leading composers and performers, including Steve Reich, Harrison Birtwistle, Mica Levi, Oliver Knussen, Marius Nesset, Jonny Greenwood, Louis Andriessen, Thurston Moore, John Woolrich, Martin Suckling, and Tyondai Braxton.

Morton has been invited as a guest leader with groups such as BIT20 in Bergen, Orchestre de Chambre de Paris, Scottish Chamber Orchestra, City of London Sinfonia, and Musikkollegium Winterhur. He is committed to sharing ideas with the next generation of string players and has directed projects at the Royal Northern College of Music, the Royal College of Music, the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, and the University of Auckland.

Morton regularly contributes to film and TV soundtracks at Abbey Road Studios and Air Lyndhurst Studios, where he leads studio orchestras for film composers including Dario Marianelli, Rael Jones, Patrick Doyle, Alex Heffes, Jóhann Jóhannsson, Christian Henson, Craig Armstrong, Joby Talbot, and Laurent Eyquem.

Morton also plays with the Colin Currie Group in Europe and Japan.

This is the first performance at the Moss Arts Center for Scottish Ensemble.

Land Acknowledgement



YMCA AT VIRGINIA TECH





Lucy Lee Lancaster

Lucy Lee Lancaster (1905–1989) challenged the boundaries of higher education for women, leaving a lasting impact on Virginia Tech and the surrounding community of Blacksburg, VA. She was one of the first five women admitted as full-time students to Virginia Tech.



After her retirement, Lucy Lee became a member of the YMCA board of directors and was a member in a regular or honorary capacity, serving for a time as Secretary, until her death. Lucy Lee made Y students welcome in her home and delighted in having them hold meetings here where they could be sure of being served lemonade and homemade cookies.

Upon her death in 1989, Lucy donated her home, the Lancaster House, to the YMCA at Virginia Tech. She made this donation in memory of her parents, William Lee Lancaster and Lucy Lee Siebold Lancaster, and her younger sister, Martha. This house continues serving as the YMCA's base of operations in Blacksburg and remains a lasting symbol of Lucy Lee Lancaster's impact on the community.
