We give thanks to the community who came together to realize this dream and to give voice to these stories. Indigenous Performance Productions was started in 2019 to expand the tour booking and management work that was migrated from Walrus Arts Management. The mission of Indigenous Performance Productions is to produce, promote, present, manage, and advance education around Indigenous performing arts and artists. Indigenous Performance Productions' vision is to create equity and opportunity for Indigenous performing artists by providing opportunity to amplify stories through live performances.

Biographies



DELBERT ANDERSON, *trumpet*

Delbert Anderson is a Diné trumpet artist, composer, and educator who attended Eastern New Mexico University studying music education and performance. Anderson is the jazz director at San Juan College, founder of the San Juan Jazz Society, and is credited as a Native American music ambassador. Anderson's music is inspired through his Navajo cultural background and fused with influences of jazz, funk, hip-hop, and Southwestern styles. Anderson has created experimental educational programs

and is known as an arts project developer. He also serves as a national and international arts consultant specializing in community development. Anderson has performed and worked with some of today's top music professionals, such as Phil Manzanera, Jon Faddis, T. S. Monk, Bobby Watson, John Lindemann (two-time Grammy-winning producer), and more. Anderson continues his mission of creating opportunities in the arts, educating Native American youth and sharing messages of hope, life, and positivity.



NOKOSEE FIELDS, *fiddle, bass, and vocals*

Nokosee Fields (Osage) was born and raised in Stillwater, Oklahoma, studying orchestral violin at a young age. After years of learning and performing classical music, Fields turned his attention to traditional American music, performing, teaching, and touring professionally. As a bassist, he tours with the country band Western Centuries, as well as the old-time band Steam Machine. As a teacher, he has taught at the Augusta Heritage Center, tutored at Centrum's festival of American fiddle tunes, and was

the artist in residence for the Portland Old-Time Music Gathering. He has placed in numerous fiddle contests and most notably took first in the 2019 Appalachian String Band Music Festival fiddle competition. Fields' lengthy and diverse experience in the performing arts gives him a unique approach to creating, listening to, and facilitating music.

JULIA KEEFE, *jazz vocals and piano*

Julia Keefe (Nez Perce), assistant director for *Welcome to Indian Country*, grew up on the Nez Perce Indian reservation in Idaho and graduated from the Manhattan School of Music's master's in music jazz vocals program in 2019 and from the University of Miami's Frost School of Music in 2011. Pre-pandemic, Keefe made her living as a New York City-based professional jazz singer in both recorded tunes and live performances. She blends a quirky sense of humor with jazz of the 1940s and '50s, creating a jovial

marmalade of smooth vocals and rapier wit. She has had the honor of opening for jazz legends, such as Tony Bennett and Esperanza Spalding. Her life's work is the revival and honoring of the Coeur d'Alene jazz musician and legend Mildred Bailey and is the leader of the campaign to induct Bailey into the Jazz Hall of Fame. NICHOLAS LUCERO, *percussion*

Born in Albuquerque, New Mexico, and raised in southern Colorado, Nicholas Lucero has had toured in the drum seat internationally with several jazz artists and nationally with artists that range from jazz, folk, blues, rock, and everything in between. Cofounder of the San Juan Jazz Society and the Indigenous Community Arts Foundation and co-creator of eight touring projects, Lucero has developed a strong focus with his musical journey: elevating modern Indigenous art and destroying

stereotypes of what Indigenous music can be. Featured in such publications as the *Smithsonian Magazine*, *Chamber Music of America Magazine*, and on Grammy.com, Lucero currently composes and tours with a jazz trio, a hip-hop focused group, symphonic arrangements of jazz and hip-hop, a musical, and continues to work with artists such as Phil Manzanera of Roxy Music, South African percussionist Dan Chiorboli, and longtime friend and bandmate Delbert Anderson.



MALI OBOMSAWIN,

bass, vocals, and guitar

Mali Obomsawin is a musician, activist, and citizen of the Abenaki First Nation at Odanak. Obomsawin is a bassist, songwriter, composer, and singer with an eclectic background in pop, free/avant-garde music, and American roots styles. She tours internationally with her indie folk rock band, Lula Wiles (Smithsonian Folkways Recordings), and gigs as a freelance bassist in New York City where she resides. As an Indigenous liberation activist and scholar, she

has most recently published her work in *Smithsonian Folklife Magazine* and the *Boston Globe*. Obomsowen received a bachelor's degree in government and comparative literature from Dartmouth College in 2018.



RENA PRIEST, poet

Rena Priest is a poet and an enrolled member of the Lhaq'temish (Lummi) Nation. Priest has been appointed to serve as Washington State's poet laureate for the term of April 2021-2023. She is also the recipient of the Vadon Foundation Fellowship (2020) and an Allied Arts Foundation Professional Poets Award (2020). She has attended residencies at Hedgebrook, Mineral School, and Hawthornden Castle. Her debut collection, *Patriarchy Blues*, was published by MoonPath Press and received an American

Book Award. Her second collection, *Sublime Subliminal*, is available from Floating Bridge Press. Individual poems are featured at Poets.org, Poetry Northwest, Pontoon Poetry, A Dozen Nothing, and elsewhere. Priest has also published non-fiction pieces in *High Country News*, *YES! Magazine*, *Seattle Met*, *Adventures NW*, and *Nautilus*. She is a National Geographic Explorer (2018-2020) and a Jack Straw Writer (2019). Priest holds a master's of fine art from Sarah Lawrence College.

Land Acknowledgement

Virginia Tech acknowledges that we live and work on the Tutelo/Monacan People's homeland and we recognize their continued relationships with their lands and waterways. We further acknowledge that legislation and practices like the Morrill Act (1862) enabled the commonwealth of Virginia to finance and found Virginia Tech through the forced removal of Native Nations from their lands, both locally and in western territories.

We understand that honoring Native Peoples without explicit material commitments falls short of our institutional responsibilities. Through sustained, transparent, and meaningful engagement with the Tutelo/Monacan Peoples and other Native Nations, we commit to changing the trajectory of Virginia Tech's history by increasing Indigenous student, staff, and faculty recruitment and retention, diversifying course offerings, and meeting the growing needs of all Virginia tribes and supporting their sovereignty.

We must also recognize that enslaved Black people generated revenue and resources used to establish Virginia Tech and were prohibited from attending until 1953. Through InclusiveVT, the institutional and individual commitment to *Ut Prosim* (That I May Serve) in the spirit of community, diversity, and excellence, we commit to advancing a more diverse, equitable, and inclusive community.

The YMCA at Virginia Tech began in 1873 and served as an integral part of the university during its early years until the mid 1960's .

From that cornerstone came the building we know today as the home for the College of Liberal Arts and Human Sciences. From 1899 until we moved to Squires Student Center, this was the Y and the center of campus.



In 1899, VT students' families, alumni, and friends gathered resources to lay the cornerstone for the Y's first building. The Y created and promoted Hokie Stone as an architectural tradition & standard (the first building with Hokie Stone)



In 1972 the Y donated the building to Virginia Tech for its bicennial.
